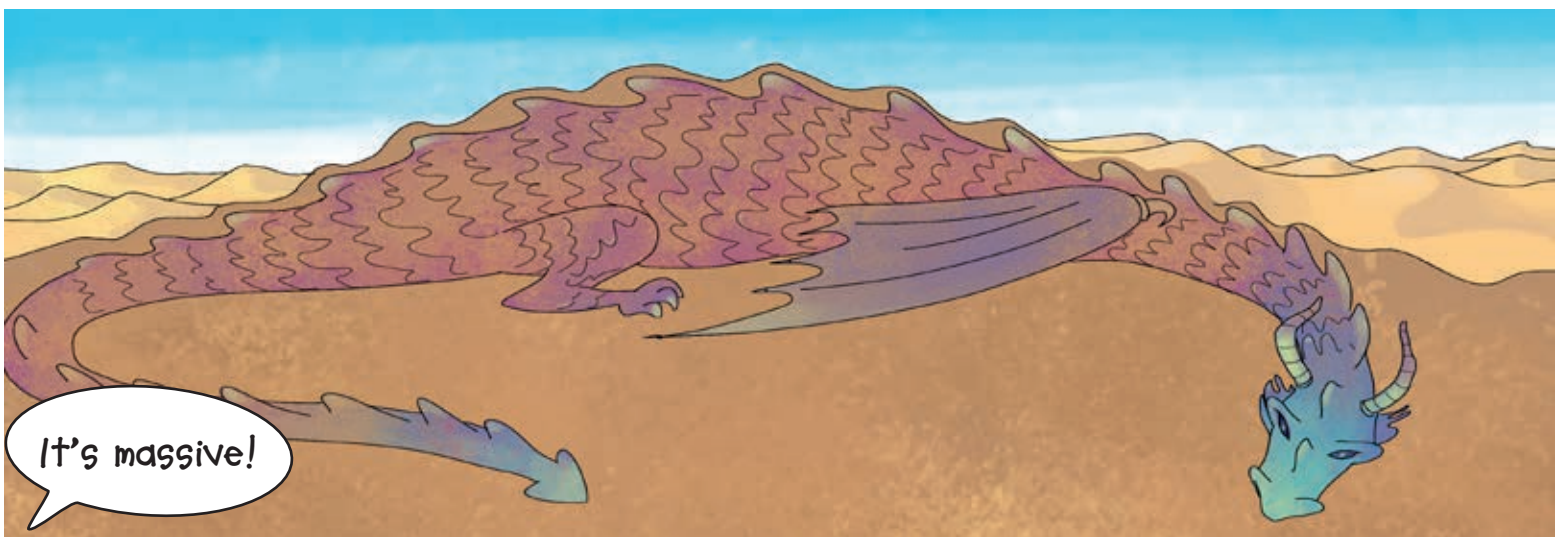


After dinner, Sally tells a wonderful story. She asks, 'Do you know the story of the sand dragon?'

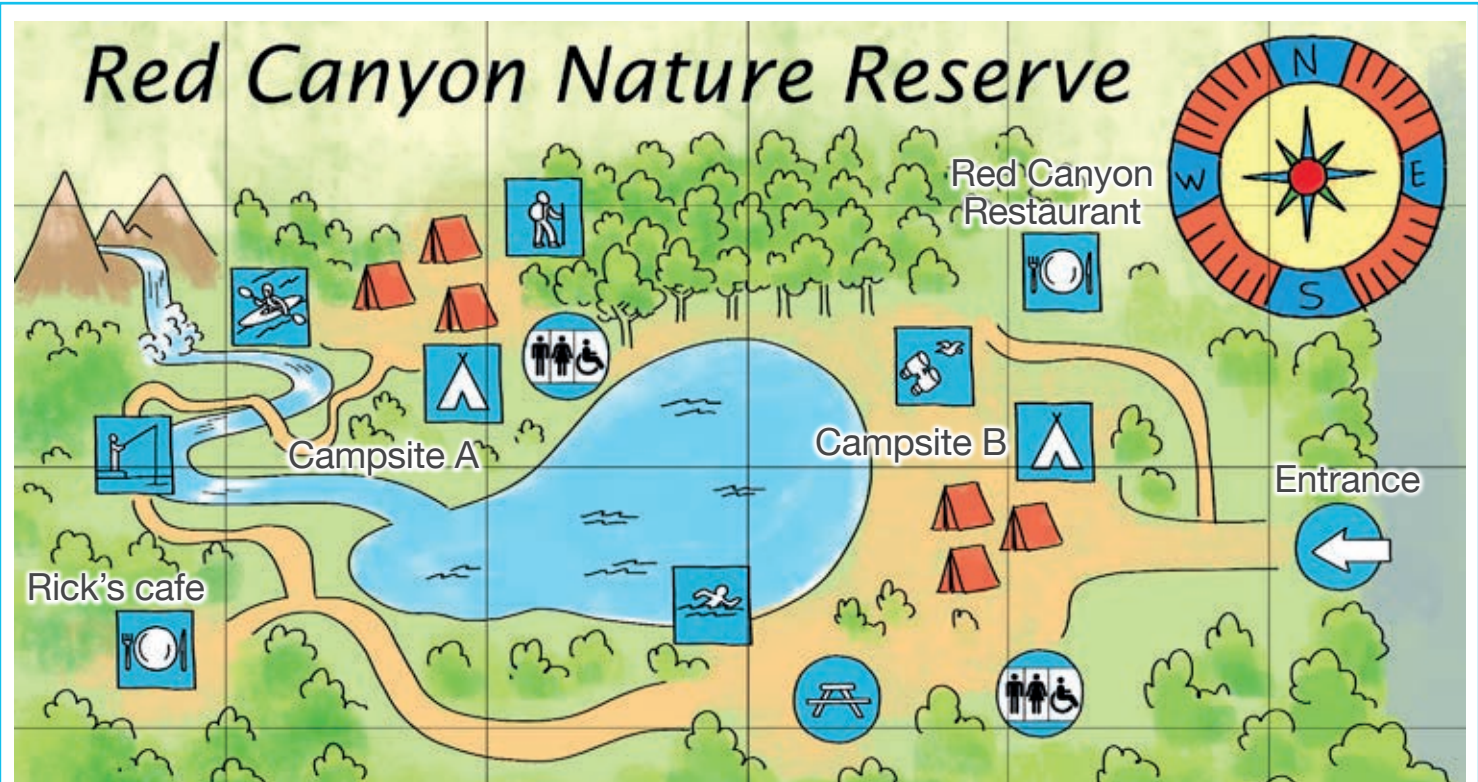
