You can take a bus, but it's better by car. Walk through **forests** of 800-year-old trees. Tofino has beautiful beaches and is the best place in Canada to go surfing.



B Calgary to Jasper

This route through the Canadian Rockies has the most beautiful **scenery**. Stop in Banff National Park and visit the natural history museum.



C Montréal to Québec City

You can drive from Montréal to Québec City in three hours. Visit the Abbey of Saint-Benoît-du-Lac. They make a traditional blue cheese there. After that, get a bike and ride round the **lake**.
